Directions:

Transform a shoebox into a float that accurately reflects your county. You may use colored paper, tissue paper, clay figures, paint, and anything else that helps you represent your county in an attractive way.

Do's:

- Have your county's name displayed on your float.
- Cover your box completely with colored paper.
- Make your float mobile. (You may add wheels or place the float on a skateboard or small toy car. NO REMOTE CARS ALLOWED!) Make sure you add a string for pulling.
- Have at least 5 items on your float that represent your county.
- Be prepared to present your float to the classroom and talk about how each item represents your county.
- Make your float as colorful, neat, and attractive as possible.

Dont's

- Have your parents spend money on items for your float.
- Put items on your float that don't represent something about the county. (Example: A puppy dog figurine, matchbox car, Barbie doll, etc.) 10 points will be deducted from your grade for each item on your float that doesn't represent the county.
- Have more than two pictures on your float.
